



In only 6 months, more than 200,000 have lost their villages and fled to live in the forest or in the urban areas, running away from gunshots and fire.

We are trying to react as fast as possible, to help as many as possible, but it's not enough.

This last month we:

- Helped 27 displaced families in Buea with the support of a religious organization. (Feeding and household items)
- Helped 17 displaced families in Muea with a local network of women activists. (Happening tomorrow, feeding and household items)
- Conducted a feasibility study in Kumba, the major host town, in preparation of a cash-based humanitarian intervention, in collaboration with Plan Cameroon and UNICEF.
- We are also doing our own research and are creating feedback mechanisms to provide realistic estimates of the number of displaced people all over the South-West.

Very soon, we expect to help roughly 3,000 displaced families with cash transfers (through UNICEF and Plan) and more than 200,000 with the provision of clean water and sanitation materials (also through UNICEF).

But so much more is needed. More families are joining the displaced masses as violence continues and major roads such as Kumba – Buea are blocked for days. Our staff are putting

their lives at risk to keep doing what we have always done, helping the destitute build up their lives. The task in front of us is immense.

These are not fighters or soldiers, they were not collaborating with anybody. They are just people whose only crime was to be in the way.
